C.HAFNER & HILDERBRAND SA adheres to RJC's ethical guidelines by not accepting gold from or through high-risk regions. We purchase our precious metals exclusively from RJC-certified suppliers who are responsible for guaranteeing their provenance and traceability.

This means that our products are not produced by child labor, slavery, or exploitation under the threat of physical or moral violence, in accordance with human rights. Furthermore, we put forth all efforts to stop transactions that aim to finance terrorism, criminal acts, corruption, tax fraud, or money laundering. C.HAFNER & HILDERBRAND SA has implemented control procedures and evaluated our suppliers to ensure the traceability of transactions.
